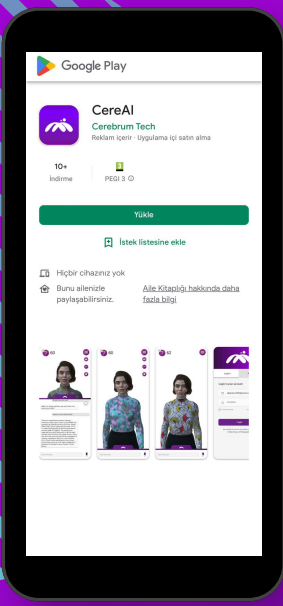


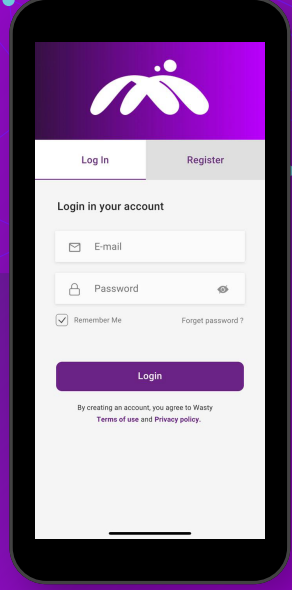
# Downloading the App and Getting Started

To install Cere on your smartphone or tablet, visit the Google Play Store or App Store and download the app for free. After downloading the application, you can begin using it.



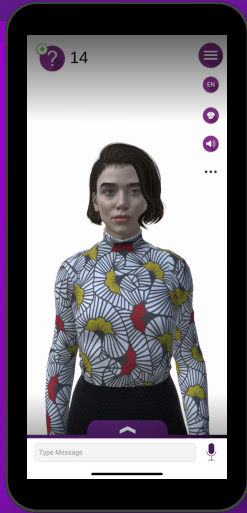
## Login and Registration
